## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Who should attend Future Hornet Day?

A: Prospective undergraduates (high school students and community college transfer students).

Q: Can I bring my family?

A: Registered students can bring a maximum of up to 4 guests.

Q: Can I bring more guests than what I originally signed up for?

A: Yes, but a maximum of 4 guests.

Q: Can I drop off my student?

A: Due to liability reasons, all students under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Q: Is a parking permit required? And, where do I park?

A: Yes, a parking permit is required for Future Hornet Day. Complimentary parking is located in Faculty/Staff/Student Parking Structure I.

Q: What do I get at Check-in?

A: You will receive your Welcome packet at check-in which includes an event agenda, admissions information, athletic voucher, discount coupon for the Hornet Bookstore, raffle ticket and a complimentary Sac State pen.

Q: What if I forget my confirmation printout?

A: You will need access to your **confirmation number** for check-in. Viewing your confirmation by using your Smart phone is another option if you are unable to print.

Q: Do I need to check out?

A: No.

Q: Do I have to stay all day?

A: Future Hornet Day (1:00 – 4:00 pm) coincides with Homecoming festivities (immediately following Future Hornet Day) and the football game (6:05 pm kickoff). Homecoming always brings out the Sac State spirit with lots of festivities, music, food and fun for the whole family. While we encourage guests to stay for the full day of activities, it is not required.

Q: Will there be food served?

A: Complimentary light refreshments will be available for all registered Future Hornet Day guests. Additional campus eateries will be open to purchase other food items. Food vendors are also available at the football game.

Q: Do I have to be registered for a Campus Tour?

A: No pre-registration required. Sac State campus tours will be offered beginning at 12:00 p.m. 45 minute walking tours will start from Housing Quad. Last tour will depart at 3:30 p.m.

Q: Where are the restrooms?

A: Restrooms are located in most of the open buildings on campus.

Q: Do I have to be present to win the raffle?

A: Yes.

Q: Can I attend two sporting events with one pass?

A: No. You must choose one sporting event to redeem your complimentary tickets.

Q: When does the Homecoming game start?

A: Kickoff for the Homecoming game is 6:05 p.m.

Q: What time is the raffle/and where?

A: We will have raffles throughout the day. Stop by the check-in table every hour to see if you won. A grand prize raffle will begin at 4:00 p.m. in Housing Quad. To enter you must return Future Hornet Day evaluation to receive raffle ticket.

Q: What is the difference between a campus tour and a housing tour?

A: A campus tour is a 45-minute walking tour of the campus grounds along with information about the services, activities, programs and educational opportunities available to students.

At a housing tour you will see and learn about our 6 residence halls, the Dining Commons, American River Courtyard Market, and outdoor amenities, which include swimming pools, tennis courts, and basketball courts.
